Two groups were divided amongst them Anju won 1st from group A and Ram secured 1st position among group B Club member and Toyaz facilitated the program.

Repair and maintenance

Broken glass was changed of the file cupboard.

Old toilet pipe was replaced by new one because the pipe got damaged and dirty water was coming out. Now, the waste water coming from kitchen and bathrooms have been separated.

New projects

The construction of collapsed wall has begun since the last of march. A sum of Rs. 50,000.- has been drawn from bank for the purchase of needful materials of construction. It is estimated that we will be spending around 150,000.- for this wall. (Aashu Excerpts)
