Anju and Bijay two children from Duhabi home got sick, Anju is 16 years old girl got infected by TB i.e. Tuberculosis and Bijay got fractured in his hand while playing swing, he felt from there. He had small crack in wrist, he got plastered in his hand which will be removed only after 40-45 days. They both were taken to the Koshi hospital which is located at

Biratnagar. The infection is seen only in Anju's sputum, x-ray and blood test are requires for further confirmation. It will be done after 2 days of taking medicine, she needs to continue medicine for 6 months. Cold drinks, cold food items, oily and spicy food and junk food is strictly prohibited to her. Proper medical treatment was given to them.

Office manager of Duhabi Home Aashu Mandal went together with them.

No conflict was seen among the children. None of the relatives visited Duhabi home. Children are helping each other and there is no such aggression in the home.





Children were happy and excited for Dashain and Tihar especially small one. On the day of Dashain, the OM puts tika in the forehead of children and children went around the home to take tika and blessings from peoples. DCH board arranged tika program at home.

On the day of Bhai tika, the children in the home celebrated bhai tika by putting tika of seven colours to boy and marigold garland by the girls.

This month was festive month so every child was happy.

After work shipping goddess Laxmi on the day of Laxmi puja, the children went to play Duesi bhailo program nearby Duhabi area.
