Health

No children suffered from serious illness. Karan bashed his head while playing, Devika too got injured they were taken to nearest medical clinic and treatment were done and vaccination were given to Devika against tetanus.



The children were feeded with nutrition diet and seasonal fruits by DCH team management.



Education

Schools were re-opened by 1st week of february. The children were very happy after the school opened. No such programs or exams held in the schools except classroom reading.

Hygiene

The house premises, toilets and bathroom are cleaned in regular basis. Home mother and kitchen mother are much more aware in cleaning and sanitization. Home mother helps small children to clean their clothes and to manage them.

Staff Duhabi home

All the staff members of DCH worked for overall 28 days without being absent except kitchen mother, she went to her house for 2 days on the occasion of Nepalese puja.
