DH hasn't discussed on any recent maintenance projects but Citizenship of Anoj and Anju are under process.

Mr. Raj Chaudhary Professional Counsellor from SOS have been appointed to give individual attention to the children so they can share their problems. He will come twice a week on Friday and Saturday.

Safety

Some of the children were suffering from skin diseases they were taken to the hospital and proper treatment was done, it took around 2 weeks for healing. To reduce such type of diseases in future Children were instructed to use their personal towels, personal soaps and no beds were shared by other child.

Repair and Maintenance

No maintenance was done during the month.

Medical issues

Two dentists from the dental hospital of BPKIHS Dharan, conducted dental camp at DH, they checked the teeth of all the children and advised us that two of them had minor dental problems and needed treatment.

Anju and Anoj decided to do stand-up on their own after passing class 10. Anju is studying in class 11 with management subjects, and as well as working as a teacher to the PG students. Along with this, Anoj is studying overseer and also teaching to the children of DH as tuition teacher, it's big achievement of DH.

Deepa Marriage

Deepa has been working as an assistant mother for about 18 months. She has been in love with the boy for 4-5 years. The groom sides are happy with marrying their son with her, they are economically strong enough to take care of her and they have enough land and property. At first, they got court marriage legally in court and after a week later they got social marriage in temple with small party by the groom sides.



Staff members

Staff members overall worked for 31 days without absent, OM was busy with the CDO office so he frequently used to visit inurawa CDO Office.

Points of Attention

- Anoj and Anju are currently pursuing citizenship; they require a citizenship card in order to travel, work, pursue higher education, and other activities. They will receive their citizenship card by the end of this month; however, it will take some time to prepare and complete the requirements in accordance with Nepalese government regulations. Additionally, the DH local board was unable to offer it owing to the illness of its chairman.
