### Hygiene

To ensure a healthy and hygienic living environment for Children. This includes daily cleaning of the toilet bowl, sink, and shower, as well as wiping down surfaces and mopping the floor regularly. Phenyl, disinfectants and cleaning agents are regularly used in toilet and bathrooms to kill germs and prevent the spread of infections.

The barber was requested to provide haircuts to the children at Duhabi Home, as it was considered unsafe to take them all to the saloon. Setting up a makeshift station, he meticulously trimmed each child's hair, giving them a stylish new look.



### Safety Measures

During the rainy season, children are advised to wear slippers at home to avoid slipping on wet surfaces. Additionally, they are encouraged to wear a raincoat when going to school to stay dry and healthy.
