Donors who bring food from outside and feed the children have been banned. If they are going to feed the children food or snacks, they are requested to bring the food items, ingredients, and the kitchen mother of DH will cook it and later feed the same food to the children. Also, do not give any food items or stationary items to the children's hands. Instead, hand them over to the home mother or the kitchen mother. Later, the food or other items will be given according to their own schedule.

### Reports of Children

Many kids had exams before the Dashain holidays. They went to school and tuition classes regularly, staying busy with their studies and terminal examination. However, some kids didn't have exams but still went to school. Once the exams were over, they enjoyed their time off during the month. They had holidays and spent a lot of time playing, drawing, helping out at home, and watching TV.



Everything was in good order, with nearly all the children in good health but Anju, regrettably, became seriously ill but was fortunate to receive exceptional care from the mothers at Home. They ensured she received the necessary medication and support for her recovery.



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Children choose new clothes for Dashain and are excited to join in the festivities like everyone else. They enjoyed receiving tika from DH board members and OM Mr. Aashu Kumar Mandal, as well as visiting neighbours for blessings.



### Education

Until the first week of October, the children underwent examinations at school. Following this period, the schools were closed, and the hired tutors conducted tuition classes in the morning and evening time.



### Beyond Education

The counsellor and OM collaborate to organize extracurricular activities for children at home, promoting creativity, teamwork, and practical skills. These activities, such as art, crafts, gardening, cooking, or sports, help children learn valuable life lessons and develop a sense of accomplishment, ensuring holistic education.

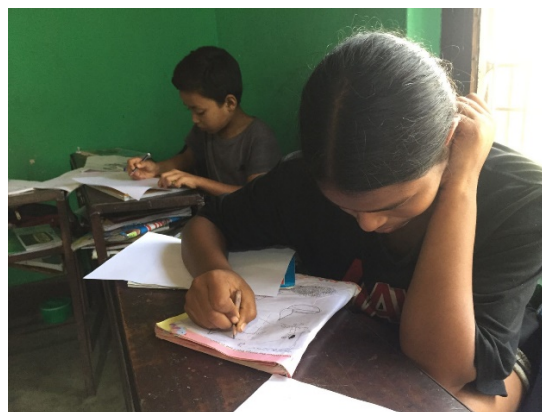

### Medical issues

The treatment eliminated the bacteria or fungi, allowing the skin to heal. They may have improved hygiene practices to prevent future infections. ### Hygiene

Mothers prioritize cleanliness in the homes to protect children's health and create a healthy living space. They clean toilets, bathrooms, and surrounding areas to minimize germ transmission. Children, especially girls, contribute significantly to maintaining cleanliness with mothers. Mothers and staff at DH teach children essential hygiene habits, such as handwashing after using the toilet and before meals.

### Safety Measures

Insecticides were applied to the front playground, and the grass was trimmed and maintained to safeguard children from the transmission of dengue and other insect-related illnesses.



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#### Staff Members

Staff members were performing well in their roles. For instance, guard assisted the OM in purchasing vegetables from the market, dropping off children at school, and running errands to buy office items. Overall, all staff members performed well in their roles.



#### New project

Duhabi home has hired a gardener to maintain their outdoor space, ensuring it remains attractive and well-maintained. The gardener ensures proper attention to plants, regular mowing, and timely repairs. This arrangement not only promotes a healthy garden but also creates a beautiful outdoor space for Children and guests. #### Points of attention
