

Food Relief Dipendra School, Falkland, Dharan-17on 8-04-20

Since 2 weeks Nepal has been in Lockdown . Even though Nepal has until now been relatively safe, the Government wants to prevent the virus to spread. The school has been closed Most parents from our Dipendraschool cannot make their daily wages because of the lockdown. They have no reserves to provide food to their children. That is why we have decided to help the families during this period with a food relief program. A total of 12 families have received support. We selected 1 family receiving the support as an example . Their situation is characteristic for all who have received , *If lockdown is continued we expect more families to ask our support* The relief was provided on april 8 in the witness of SHC chairman Mr. Meharman Hughes , Dipendra School committee Chairwoman Ms. Mina Lawoti. The relief packet constituted the daily grocery comprising of 1 sack of rice (25 kg), Lentils (1.5 kg), Oil (1.5 litre), a salt packet, 1 bar soap to each family worth total € 20= NPR 2514
