### **Academic activities**

Scholarship program to Dalit children was conducted in the school. The fund was provided by the government only for the dalit children. According to the children registered in 2018, out of 112 children, 60 children (Both Boys and girls) were dalit. Each child got Rs 400 (Euro 3.2) which was distributed by the founder committee president Mr. SurajBaraily, President Mrs.MinaLawati and Advisor Mr. Tilakbahadur Sunuwar.

## **8. Teacher’s parents meeting**

Dipendra School organized second parents meet on May 30 on the important agenda on "Contribution from Parents" for betterment of children and school. Today 40 parents participated in the meeting. After long discussion, finally parents and guardians are convinced to contribute from their side with some amount.

At the same meeting hall, parents and guardians agreed to contribute Rs.10 per day from now onwards excluding holidays. Other remaining parents will also be notified and motivated during their visit to school.
