1	Academic activities	Description
	Educational performance (Overall)	<p>In this month, teachers were more concentrated towards first terminal examination. They helped children in revision classes, subject test for the improvement of their study. Also regular test were conducted from 26th of June from class 1-6. The first terminal examination will be held on July 7, 2019</p> <p>For the improvement of English language, Mr. Jovan voluntarily took his classes on every Tuesday and Friday from class 1-6. Also on Friday, English class for teacher after school was conducted which was very fruitful. Teachers came to learn various vocabularies, pronunciation and others things.</p>
	Regularity of the students	Because of high humidity this month, various problems like headache and vomiting occurred in some students at home and school. Therefore, most of the children were not able to join their classes regularly. Daily, 2-3 children from each class were absent.
	Course coverage by teachers	As all the teachers were more concerned for upcoming final terminal examination, they have covered up all the courses. Also, they conducted revision class for children.

	Cleaning, gardening, activities, support to teachers etc.	<p>On the occasion of World Environment Day, on 5th June, all the teachers and students of class 1-6 were involved in cleaning and gardening program. Teachers were fully involved in safety of the children during the event.</p> <p>Also on 23rd June teachers organized small plantation program of 20 minutes with students.</p>

	Formation of child club and its activities	Child club have become more innovative this month. They organized a meeting on June 21 on the division of work and events among the members. They are also taking skill development class from Mrs Bishnu every Friday for 30 minutes. Children club whole heartedly participate in various extra curriculum activities during Fridays.
	Participation of activities organized by outsiders, others and school itself	On 12 th June, health program was organized by BPKIHS for the awareness of Dengue fever. Almost 52 parents were present in the program and some preventive measures were presented by local health care centre on the same day.

11	Teacher’s feedback on enhancement on academic performance and management	Some of the feedbacks of the teachers are listed below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teachers have requested to increase their present salary as it has become very difficult to maintain their standards. 2. Teachers requested to increase the dining hall for children as the children don’t have enough space while they eat. Some big children have to sit outside and take their meal during Tiffin time.

Some parents have requested to provide home works so that children can study at home too. They also requested to make some strict rules like: wearing proper school uniform in school.
