### **Staff Meeting**

There was no formal meeting held at Duhabi Children Home but the chairperson Mr. Keshav Bhattarai and secretary Mr. Ramesh Thapa regularly visited Duhabi home and monitored the work done and the activities of the manager, mothers and observed the progress of children.

### **Reports of Children**

There were no such conflicts seen between the children, they seem friendly during the month. Small children; Ram, Karuna, Shristy, Khushi and Pratima got sick and were taken to nearest clinic for check-up. Now, they are well and others remained fit and healthy during the month.

Physically School re-opened from 12<sup>th</sup> September 2021. School opened 10 to 4 for elder children. Classes were run from 20<sup>th</sup> September for smaller one. Before that they were having online virtual classes and home tuitions.



On the occasion of children's day, ministry of Social Development and welfare conducted online oratory competition by the medium of Zoom meeting. Anoj Gautam from Duhabi Children Home participated in the program where as the participants were from different NGOs and Child care homes of province1. Anoj tried his best from his

side but could not get under 3<sup>rd</sup> position he was fourth and was given certificate of appreciation and cash worth rs1000/- as prize.

On the next day 15<sup>th</sup> of September, province no.1 children's federation conducted physical quiz competition and drawing competition program at itahari where Anoj and Milan took part in quiz competition and Ritan Raut in drawing competition, they were representative Duhabi Home. Certificate of appreciation were given to them.



During this month parents of Karan and Karuna visited to Duhabi home, they both were drunk at the moment so they were not allowed to come inside, they were sitting at ground and talked with their children. Mr. Ramesh Tamrakar was with office manager inside the office preparing plans and budget. Without permission, the parents took the younger boy Karan with them and tried to escape from home.

Duhabi Home received 50 outdoor and indoor flowering and non-flowering plants with the collaboration of Duhabi Municipality and planted on the premises.

Dance classes and computer classes were stopped till this month. We hope to continue these classes from next month.

### Visit report of Ramesh Tamrakar

Representative, Director/Supervisor of Stichting Shide Children Home, Mr. Ramesh Tamrakar visited Duhabi Home on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2021, on that day there was discussion with the children profile, child development plan and staff profile and met with chairman, mothers and children.

On next day visited CDO office to discuss on the stalemate of SHC and misuse of fund by managers of SHC, on the same day he went to Sita's house at Itahari. Sita seems happy and settled in her new home with new family. We are happy to see her adjusted in new environment. The mother-in-law also seems happy with Sita.

The Supervisor/Director evaluated last year's plans and budget and prepared plans and budget for next year i.e. 2022.

### Health

All the children are safe and healthy. However Ram, Karuna, Shristy, Khushi and Pratima had suffered from sneezing and coughing due to the change of the season. They were taken to the clinic nearby Duhabi home for check up and went for follow up then after. They have recovered now and taken care by mothers. Home mothers had provided them home remedies too, Deepa helped them to take medicines on the time.

**Education**

Schools were re-opened after 8 months long interval. Children were feeling bored at home. In the morning and evening time children were involved in tuition classes. The classes were divided in two groups, morning time for primary level and evening for elder one.

**Maintenance**

Minor maintenance are taken care regularly. Fused bulb and capacitor of fans were changed.

**Feedback from staff about children**

Children were seen friendly among each other but sometimes small children quarrel with each other. Toyaz did not change his behaviour and doesn't ask to anyone while going to outside with his colleagues and classmates.



**Hygiene**

Cleaning of toilet, bathroom, surrounding is done in regular basis by home mother and children. Children were advised to use their personal things due to the spreading of virus and viral fever.

**Staff Duhabi home**

Staff members were present in whole month except in weekend. Office manager is taking overall responsibility of buying items from markets, maintaining office record.

Both mothers share the work in cooking and taking care of children at home.



**Child club programme**

Cleaning and sanitization program were done regularly by club members. On the occasion of children's day club members of Duhabi home conducted quiz competition, free drawing competition and speech competition among the Duhabi home children. All of them performed well and prizes were distributed to them.

**Safety measures**

All the children were advised to bath regularly, wear mask while going outside and wash hand frequently with soap and water to reduce the chance of corona virus.
