### Education

Children were regular with their School and tuition classes.

### Hygiene

Cleanliness of toilet, bathroom, surrounding is done in regular basis by home mother and sometimes by children. Children were directed to use their personal things due to the spreading of virus and viral fever.

### Staff Members

Staff members worked overall 30 days without any absence in work.

To make the children stay away from injuries, they are advised and suggested to play carefully in the grounds and to wear full clothes while playing.
