Small children like Karan Karuna and Shristi suffered from fever and cough due to the change in season , they were taken to hospital medical treatment were given to them.

Most of the children had examination during this month. They attended their school and examination regularly and they were busy with their exam and study but some children didn't have exam but they had regular classes. Lockdown started from 20th of April and all of the children school closed due to the rapid increase in Covid-19 cases.



They had holidays and they are spending most of their time in playing, making drawings, watching TV and helping at home. During the free time children were having extra class by tuition teacher in the day time.

Sita returned back to Duhabi home from Hetauda on 15th July 2021, in the beginning she was happy with the work but after few days she don't find reliable there so she left working place. She is teaching small children and doing house hold work of Duhabi home.

All the children were having their terminal examination during this month; all of them had attended their tuition, dance class with hired tutor. According to their tutor Siwani, Nishan is slow in learning whereas Toyaz is changing his behaviour and attending tuition class and school regularly.

Maintenance

With the support of local donor this month Duhabi home have started the construction work of toilet at first floor and the old toilet have been changed into store room. Two damaged fans were repaired during this month.



Feedback from staff about children:

Small children play in such a way that mothers get afraid if they get hurt, mothers take care of them most of the time.

Hygiene

Cleanliness of toilet, bathroom, surrounding is done in regular basis by home mother and sometimes by children.

Toyaz secured 2nd position in 4 x400 meter relay race, organized by Itahari municipality he was honoured by medals and certificate by committee.

Staff members work for overall 30 days without being absent.

All the children were advised to bath regularly, wear mask while going to outside and wash their hand frequently with soap and water to reduce the chance of corona virus.

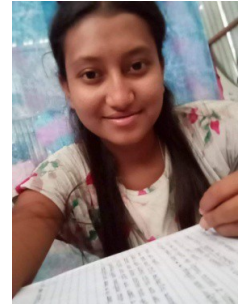
Calamities
